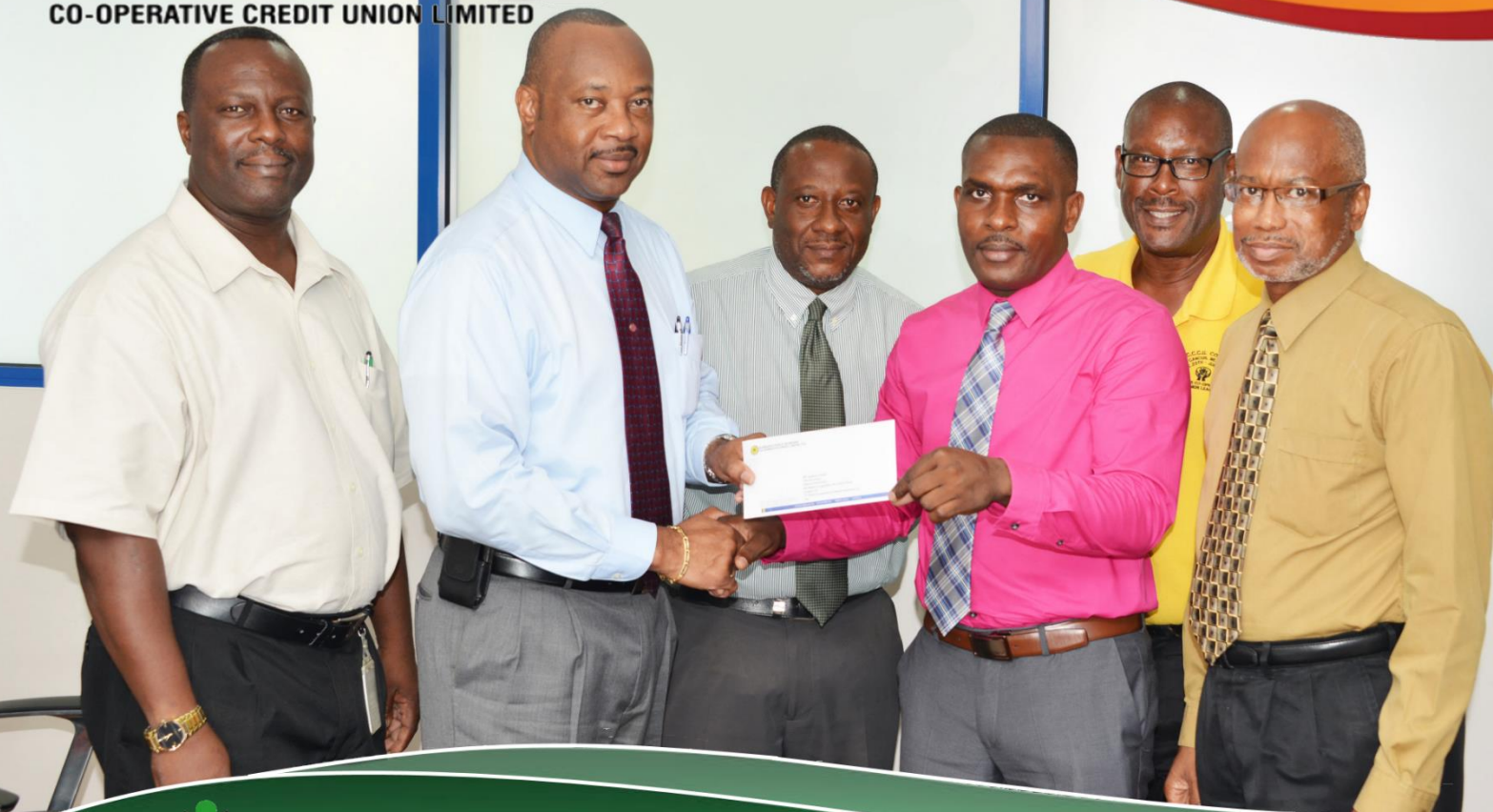

GIVE \$50,000.00 IN AID TO DOMINICA

September 16, 2015 – In an effort to reach out to as many Dominican credit union members as possible, in order to bring both immediate and long-term relief, the **Barbados Co-operative & Credit Union League** has embarked on an initiative to give aid to the people of Dominica. One of the first credit unions to lend assistance was the **Barbados Public Workers' Co-Operative Credit Union** and its subsidiary, **Capita Financial Services Inc.**

The sum of **\$50,000.00** was recently handed over to the Barbados League, as Dominicans try to rebuild after the devastation caused by Tropical Storm Erika. **According to President of the League, Barry Hunte, "We are very heartened by the ready response from Public Workers' and Capita as this is a very significant contribution and will go a long way in providing financial and emergency relief to our Dominican brothers and sisters. The donation is in keeping with the credit union philosophy of 'members helping members'."**

The Barbados Co-operative & Credit Union League has already transferred the funds to the Dominica Co-operative Societies League Limited.
